CHALLENGE QUILT: The quilt challenge this year, to be displayed at YQF is **"FLOWER POWER"**. The limit on the circumference is 144" (all four sides added together). It seems most quilters avoid the colors ORANGE and PURPLE, so to add to the challenge, you must include these colors in your quilt. **[Editor's Note: These are due at the Aug 27th meeting, and will be voted on for Member's Choice]**

Also remember the YQF quilt block challenge. It is 12-1/2 x 12-1/2 with the theme "WY SKY" and due by Aug 27th with Ann Jefferis collecting them.
