BLOCK CHALLENGE theme “**What’s blooming in Wyoming**”. There

will be a prize for People’s Choice, and the blocks will then be used in next year’s raffle quilt. Size: Unfinished Challenge Blocks must be 12 ½ inches square. Please limit doodads for ease of quilting and washing.

2019 GUILD BROWN BAG QUILT CHALLENGE theme is also “**What’s Blooming in Wyoming**”?

Each participant in the Challenge will receive a **Brown Bag** with donated fabrics.

A recognizable portion of the donated fabric must appear in the Challenge quilt, along with any fabric that you wish to add. Excess donated fabric can be used on the back of the quilt.

SIZE: The Challenge Quilt size will be from a 96" circumference to 300" circumference (all four sides added together).

DUE: The finished **Challenge Quilts** will be due at the August meeting so they can be hung together at Yellowstone Quilt Fest.

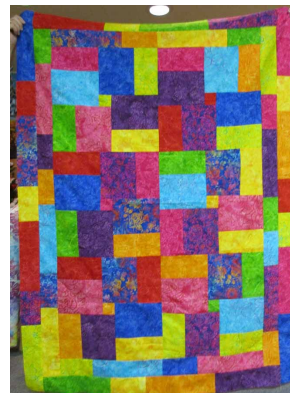
